CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Leslie J. Stewart has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pump, pond and ditch for stock water

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Sec. 4, T.41N., R.40E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the W 1/2 corner of Sec. 9 T.41N., R.40E., M.D.B.&M. bears S. 13° 01' W. a distance of 7.953 feet situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: William Stock Farming Co.
Post-office address: Paradise Valley, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.0312 c.f.s. or sufficient water to water 1,000 head of cattle
Period of use, from: January 1 to December 31 of each year

* Date of priority of appropriation: April 9, 1971

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:
The water is developed by means of a drilled well, pump and motor thence into a small pond thence into a ditch where it is used to water 1,000 head of cattle in the W 1/2 Sec. 4, and the E 1/2 E 1/2 Sec. 5, all in T.41N., R.40E., M.D.B.&M.

* This certificate changes the point of diversion and place of use of Permit 26042, hence the date of priority of appropriation is the same as that of Permit 26042.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
