CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Don M. Gordon has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pump and pressurized water system for quasi-municipal purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Sec. 23, T.20N., R.19E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the W 1/4 corner of said Sec. 23 bears N. 62° 10' W., a distance of 1,552 feet situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.075 c.f.s., but not to exceed 1.095 m.g.a.
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation March 19, 1973

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
The water is developed by means of a drilled well, pump and 600 feet of 2" water line which is used in 3 dwellings located in the same subdivision as that of the point of diversion, for quasi-municipal purposes.

This certificate is subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
