CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Alan S. Boyack, agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Chicken Creek through a dam and ditches for irrigation purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 6, T. 37N., R. 54E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE corner of Sec. 33, T. 38N., R. 54E., M.D.B.&M. bears N. 54° 51' 57" E., a distance of 14,891.51 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

\* This certificate changes the point of diversion and place of use of Permit 2160, hence the date of priority of appropriation is the same as Permit 2160.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and with the understanding that the total duty of water from any and/or all sources shall not exceed 4.0 acre feet per acre per season.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
