

THE STATE OF NEVADA
CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, J. R. Caldwell, agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from underground through a drilled well, pump and sprinkler system for irrigation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 25 T.34N. R.37E. M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the NE corner of said Sec. 25 bears N. 89° 55' E., 1,305.20 feet situated in Pershing County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.8 cfs but not to exceed 139.16 acre feet per annum
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
\* Date of priority of appropriation September 25, 1964

Description of land to which the water is appurtenant:
34.79 acres in the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 25, T.34N., R.37E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and with the understanding that the total duty of water from any and/or all sources shall not exceed 4.0 acre feet per acre per year.

\* This certificate changes the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of Permit 25502, which changed the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of Permit 22263, hence the date of priority of appropriation is the same as Permit 22263.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
