CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Richard W. Arden, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Wire Spring through excavation and earthen pond for stock water purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Sec. 27 T. 6S. R. 39E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW corner of said Sec. 27, bears N. 38° 16' 21" W., a distance of 3,212.77 feet situated in Esmeralda County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Henry F. and Virginia L. Howison
Post-office address Lida, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.0022 cfs or sufficient water to water 100 head of cattle
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation September 19, 1969

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:
The water is developed from the spring due to excavation at the spring site, thence to an earthen reservoir 6 feet high with a surface area of approximately 2.2 acres constructed in the natural channel and from which the cattle water, located in the same subdivision as that of the diversion.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
