CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Richard W. Arden, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Pigeon Spring through natural flow, and two ponds for stock water purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Sec. 17 T.6S., R.39E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE corner of said Sec. 17 bears N. 6° 15' 59" E., a distance of 2,864.10 feet situated in Esmeralda County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Henry F. and Virginia L. Howison  
Post-office address Lida, Nevada  
Amount of appropriation 0.0047 cfs or sufficient water to water 150 head of cattle  
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year  
Date of priority of appropriation September 19, 1969

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:  
The water is developed from the spring by natural flow through a small ditch to a pond of ± 0.21 acre foot capacity, thence to a second pond of ± 0.39 acre feet capacity where 150 head of cattle water directly from the ponds which are located in the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
