CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Richard W. Arden, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Kline Spring through a diversion box, pipeline and watering trough for stock water purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Sec. 14, T.6S., R.39E., M.D.B.&M, or at a point from which the SW corner of Sec. 22, T.6S., R.39E., M.D.B.&M. bears S. 58° 23' 46" W., a distance of 10,939.76 feet situated in Esmeralda County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Henry F. and Virginia L. Howison

Post-office address Lida, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.0017 cfs or sufficient water to water 50 head of cattle

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year

Date of priority of appropriation September 19, 1969

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

The water is developed at the spring by a gravel-packed round steel diversion tank and piped through a 1" pipeline 100 feet to a 200 gallon redwood water trough located in the same subdivision as that of the point of diversion where it is used for the watering of 50 head of cattle.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
