CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Richard W. Arden, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Cartier Spring through a diversion box, pipeline, storage tank and distribution system for quasi-municipal and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Sec. 35, T.5S., R.40E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the E 1/4 corner of said Sec. 35 bears S. 75° 26' 40" E., a distance of 4,829.69 feet situated in Esmeralda County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.056 cfs but not to exceed 2.56 m.g.a.
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation January 14, 1972

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

A diversion box collects the spring water which is then piped through a 4" pipeline approximately 3/4 of a mile to a 10,000 gallon storage tank, thence through a distribution system to the Lida Townsite in the SW 1/4 of Sec. 36 T.5S., R.40E., M.D.B.&M. where it is used for quasi-municipal and domestic purposes for 7 dwelling units. This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
