CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, A. J. Shoofey, agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from underground (Las Vegas Artesian Basin) through drilled well and distribution system for quasi-municipal purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 9, T.21S., R.61E. M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the N.E. corner of said Sec. 9 bears N. 22° 48' E., 945.34 feet situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of ~~NRS-318.435~~ Sec. 72, Chap. 46, Stat. of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is diverted by a drilled well and distribution system and is used for quasi-municipal purposes in the operation of a 404 room hotel with appurtenant swimming pools and landscaping, located within the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 9 and the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 10, T.21S., R.61E. M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
