CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Richard W. Arden, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for quasi-municipal and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 10, T.10N., R.22E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Sec. 10 bears S. 43° 40' E. a distance of 1,858.0 feet situated in Douglas County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.238 cfs, not to exceed 12.6 MG annually
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation August 25, 1969

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
The water is developed by means of a drilled well and pumped into a 10,000 gallon storage tank from which it is conveyed to 24 single family residences by means of 2,500 feet of 4 inch water main. All located within Section 10, T.10N., R.22E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
