CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Mark Chilton, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Flynn Spring through a collection box, pipeline and distribution system for quasi-municipal purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 1, T.26N., R.57E., M.D.B.&M or at a point from which the SE corner of the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 of said Sec. 1 bears S.86°02' E. a distance of 488.26 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Post-office address Elko, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.15 cfs, not to exceed 5.78 MGA
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation February 2, 1970

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a wooden collection box and is conveyed through a distribution system, where it is used to service 11 dwellings within the SE 1/4 NW 1/4, NE 1/4 SW 1/4, and the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 all in Sec. 1, T.26N., R.57E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
