CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Eugene B. Longfield, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for quasi-municipal and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 4, T.20N., R.24E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE corner of said Sec. 4 bears N. 83° 49' 07" E. a distance of 1,761.80 feet situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.156 cfs, not to exceed 0.992 MG annually
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation December 13, 1972

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a drilled well and is pump into a pressure tank where it is conveyed through a distribution system to the Wadsworth Natchez Elementary School located within the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 4, T.20N., R.24E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
