CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Richard W. Arden, agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

Excelsior Spring through collection box, pipeline and watering trough for Stock water

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 30, T.5S., R.40E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW corner of Section 9, T.6S., R.39E., M.D.B.&M. bears S. 54° 24' 14" W. a distance of 28,684.52 feet.

situated in Esmeralda County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Henry F. Howison and Virginia L. Howison
Post-office address Lida, Nevada
Amount of appropriation .001 cfs or sufficient water to water 60 head of cattle
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation September 19, 1969

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:
The water is developed at the spring by means of a collection box, thence piped through 1 1/2 inch plastic pipe to a 4' x 16' watering tank located in the same 40 acre subdivision as the point of diversion for watering 60 head of cattle.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
