CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Kenneth J. Oxborrow has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pump and ditch for irrigation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 19, T.21S., R.54E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the SW corner of said Sec. 19 bears S. 48° 57' 00" W. a distance of 2000.16 feet situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Kenneth J. & Kathleen Oxborrow
Post-office address: Pahrump, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.1395 cfs but not to exceed 39.45 acre feet per annum
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
* Date of priority of appropriation: May 19, 1952

Description of land to which the water is appurtenant: 7.89 acres in the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Sec. 19, T.21S., R.54E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and with the understanding that the total duty of water from any/or all sources shall not exceed 5.0 acre feet per acre annually.

* This certificate changes the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of Permit 14299, hence the date of priority remains the same as Permit 14299.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
