

THE STATE OF NEVADA
CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Fred Knell, president has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Park Canyon Creek and tributaries through a diversion headgate, ditch and settling pond for mining and milling purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Sec. 35, T.14N., R.42E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the SE corner of said Sec. 35, bears S. 58° 30' E., a distance of 3,250 feet situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 2.0 cfs but not to exceed 2.92 m.g.a.
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation May 23, 1968

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

The water is diverted by means of a 4' x 2' x 1' headgate into an adjacent holding pond where it is then transferred by a 2' x 2' ditch approximately 710 feet in length to settling ponds located in the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 and NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 35, T.14N., R.42E., M.D.B.&M. where it is used for mining and milling purposes.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
