CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, J. V. Caselli, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pump and irrigation system for irrigation

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 10, T.20S., R.53E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the S 1/4 corner of said Sec. 10 bears S 12° 06' E., a distance of 977.81 feet situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Robert H. Ruud
Post-office address: Pahrump, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.76 c.f.s., not to exceed 333.32 ac.ft. per season
Period of use, from March 1 to November 1 of each year
* Date of priority of appropriation: December 13, 1943

Table with 2 columns: Description of land to which the water is appurtenant; and Acres. Rows include various quarter sections (e.g., NW 1/4 NE 1/4, SE 1/4 NE 1/4) and a total of 360.46 acres.

*This certificate changes the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of Permit 11038, Certificate 4569; hence the date of priority of appropriation remains the same as that of Permit 11038.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and with the understanding that the total duty of water shall not exceed 5.0 acre-feet per acre per season from any and/or all sources.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
