CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Dooley P. Wheeler, Jr., Gen'l. Manager has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pump, tanks and trucks for mining and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 28, T.16N., R.57E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW corner of said Sec. 28 bears N. 87° 08' W a distance of 1,143.0 feet situated in White Pine County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.029 c.f.s., not to exceed 1.75 m.g. per season
Period of use, from April 1st to December 1st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation July 30, 1971

Description of works of diversion, place and manner of use:
Water is pumped from a well into two storage tanks and hauled by truck to the places of use located within portions of Sections 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 28, 29, 30, 31 and 32 in T.16N., R.57E., M.D.B.&M., and there used for mining (exploratory drilling) and domestic purposes.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
