CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER**

WHEREAS, J. R. Caldwell, agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through well, pump, pipeline and watering troughs for stock watering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 2, T.39N., R.39E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW corner of Sec. 3, T.39N., R.39E., M.D.B.&M. bears N. 88° 53' W., a distance of 6437.0 feet situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Alvin Miller

Post-office address Winnemucca, Nevada

Amount of appropriation .033 c.f.s., or sufficient water to water 2,000 head of cattle

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year

Date of priority of appropriation September 6, 1972

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water is developed by means of a drilled well, and is conveyed through 0.75 miles of 1 1/2" pipe and 0.75 miles of 1 1/2" pipe to fill three 4'x11'x2' watering troughs. The water is used to water 2,000 head of cattle in the W 1/2 W 1/2 Section 2, T.39N., R.39E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
