

**THE STATE OF NEVADA
CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER**

WHEREAS, Mark Chilton, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Thompson Creek Springs through collection boxes, pipeline and watering tanks for Stock water and Domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 11, T.32N., R.57E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW corner of said Sec. 11, bears S. 48° 54' 32" W., a distance of 4,565.6 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

* Amount of appropriation 0.0634 c.f.s., or sufficient water to water 2,000 head of cattle and 30 head of horses.
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation November 1, 1973

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
The water is developed through two spring collection boxes where it is fed through a 2 1/2" pipeline to a 1,000 gallon holding tank. The water is then distributed through a 2 1/2" pipeline and nine 500 gallon stock tanks located within the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Sec. 2, S 1/2 SE 1/4, NW 1/4 SE 1/4, NE 1/4 SW 1/4, S 1/2 NW 1/4 of Sec. 3, SE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Sec. 4, and the N 1/2 NW 1/4, SE 1/4 NW 1/4, SW 1/4 NE 1/4, NW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Sec. 11, all in T.32N., R.57E., M.D.B.&M. The water is used to water 2,000 head of cattle and 30 head of horses.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

* This certificate corrects the permit which was issued for only 1,000 head of cattle instead of the 2,000 head of cattle applied for.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
