 CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Alan S. Boyack, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pipeline and troughs for stock watering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 33, T.38N., R.54E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE corner of the said Sec. 33 bears N. 86°43'30" E., a distance of 678.00 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

 Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
 Date of priority of appropriation April 16, 1974

Description of works of diversion, place and manner of use:
Water is diverted from a flowing dug well with 4' 3/4" dia. casing through 1.6 miles of 1 1/4" pipe to watering troughs located within the following subdivisions, where it is used for stock watering purposes:

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
