CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Charles C. Armuth, Jr., City of Elko  
director of public works has presented to the State Engineer  
of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from  
an underground source  
through a drilled well, pump and pipelines for  
municipal  
purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 13, T.34N.,  
R.55E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the N 1/4 corner of said Sec.  
13 bears N. 23°42'00" W., a distance of 1,255.78 feet  
situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date,  
source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.9804 c.f.s.  
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year  
Date of priority of appropriation December 18, 1974

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:  
The water is pumped from the well and is introduced immediately  
into the City of Elko distribution system where it is used for  
municipal purposes within the city limits of Elko.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the  
amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
