CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Robert H. Babb, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

an underground source through a drilled well, pump, storage tank and pipelines for municipal

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 1, T47N, R64E MDB&M or at a point from which the SW corner of said Sec. 1 bears S. 21° 14' W. a distance of 1342.81 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Unincorporated Town of Jackpot

Post-office address Jackpot, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.33 cfs

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year

Date of priority of appropriation October 4, 1971

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

The water is developed by means of a drilled well and is pumped to two storage reservoirs of 400,000 gallon capacity.

Thence through 6", 8" and 10" distribution system to be used for municipal purposes by the Town of Jackpot located within Sec. 1,

E 1/2 Sec. 2, E 1/2 Sec. 11, and Sec. 12, T47N, R64E, MDB&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit, with the understanding that the total duty of water under this certificate and certificate number 6240 issued under Permit 22344 shall not exceed 77.85 million gallons per annum.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
