CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, C. H. Ketcham, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pump and pipeline for mining and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 25, T.37N., R.31E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Sec. 25 bears S. 56° 54' E., a distance of 863.4 feet situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.223 c.f.s., not to exceed 6.24 MGA
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation November 4, 1971

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is pumped from well through pipeline to a washing plant and from there is discharged into three settling ponds from which it is pumped for reuse in the settling plant, where it is used for mining and domestic purposes, all located within the SE 1/4 of Sec. 25, T.37N., R.31E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
