CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Richard W. Forman, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use from an underground source through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for quasi-municipal purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 2 T16N. R63E MDB&M or at a point from which the S 1/4 corner of said Section 2 bears S. 36° 58' 31" W. a distance of 733.3 feet situated in White Pine County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.067 c.f.s. but not to exceed 2.19 m.g.a.
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation June 20, 1973

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a drilled well and is conveyed through a distribution system to 20 mobile home units within the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and further that the total duty of water allowed under this certificate and the certificate issued under Permit 28438 shall not exceed 2.19 m.g.a.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
