CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Clinton E. Stay, agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for municipal

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 6, T20S, R61E, MDB&M, or at a point from which the SW corner of said Sec. 6 bears S. 43° 23' 50" W., a distance of 1897.13 feet situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
* Date of priority of appropriation January 14, 1955

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed from the well and thence pumped by city transmission lines to the place of use (see attached description) where it is used for municipal purposes.

*This certificate changes the point of diversion, manner and place of use of a portion of Permit 15972, Certificate 7912; hence the date of priority of appropriation remains the same as Permit 15972, Certificate 7912.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.

All of Sections 6, 7, 8; the South one-half ($S\frac{1}{2}$) of Section 9; $S\frac{1}{2}$ $SW\frac{1}{4}$, Section 13; all of Sections 15 through 36; all in Township 19 South, Range 61 East, M.D.B.&M.

The East one-half ($E\frac{1}{2}$) of Section 12; all of Sections 13, 14, and 15; all of Sections 19 through 36; all in Township 19 South, Range 62 East, M.D.B.&M.
