CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Alan S. Boyack, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through well, pump and watering trough for stock watering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 9, T. 32N., R. 56E., M.D.M., or at a point from which the NW corner of said Sec. 9 bears N. 70° 37' 13" W., a distance of 2,017.58 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.018 cfs, or sufficient to water 500 head of cattle
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation September 25, 1973

Description of works of diversion, place of use and manner of use:
Water is developed in a 8" dia. well 210 ft. deep whence it is pumped to 42 ft. diameter by 2 ft. watering trough located in the same legal subdivision as the point of diversion where it is used for stock watering purposes.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
