CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Joe Eldridge, Permittee has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Castle Rock Spring through a diversion dam, pipeline and reservoir for Stock Watering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 34, T 15 N, R 69 E, MDB&M or at a point from which the NW corner of said Sec. 34 bears N. 26° 08' W a distance of 1,200 feet situated in White Pine County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Joe Eldridge
Post-office address Baker, Nevada - via Ely, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.0031 cfs or sufficient water to water 100 head of cattle
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation December 6, 1943

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed at the spring by means of a dam, 20 feet long by 6 feet high, and is then piped 400 feet through a 2-inch pipe to a 50 ft. diameter by 3 feet deep reservoir. Water is used to water 100 head of cattle located within the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 34, T 15 N, R 69 E, MDB&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

This certificate corrects the Certificate Record No. from 8882 to 8900.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
