CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, David E. Iveson has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through well, pump and irrigation system for irrigation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 24, T.35N., R.23E., M.D.M., or at a point from which the N 1/4 corner of the said Sec. 24 bears N. 24° 14' E., a distance of 37.5 feet situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator David E. Iveson
Post-office address Gerlach, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 2.0 cfs but not to exceed 1,447.94 acre feet per annum
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
\* Date of priority of appropriation August 6, 1962

Table with 10 columns: Description of land to which the water is appurtenant, and 9 columns for acreage breakdown. Total: 463 acres total.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit with the understanding that the total duty of water shall not exceed 4.0 acre-feet per annum from any and/or all sources.

\*This certificate changes the point of diversion of a portion of Permit 23519, which changed the point of diversion of Permit 20624; hence the date of priority is the same as Permit 20624.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
