CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Mark Chilton, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Bog Springs through collection box and stockwatering pond for Stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 17, T. 47N., R. 57E., MDB&M, or at a point from which the SW corner of said Section 17 bears S. 57° 53' E., a distance of 987.5 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Howard Ranches, Inc., Verland Stowell and Owen Barton
Post-office address: Grassmere, Idaho
Amount of appropriation: 0.023 cfs. or sufficient to water 800 head of cattle and 50 horses
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: October 19, 1970

Description of works of diversion, place of use and manner of use:
Water is developed in a perforated collection box, from which it flows to a stockwatering pond located in the same subdivision as the point of diversion and there used for stockwatering purposes.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
