CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Perry Aikins has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through well, pump, pressure tank and distribution for Commercial and Domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 29, T. 15N., R. 20E., MDB&M, or at a point from which the NW corner of the said Sec. 29 bears N. 31° 05' 20" W., a distance of 1,707.70 feet situated in Carson City County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Perry Aikins
Post-office address: Carson City, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.1 cfs, but not to exceed 0.402 m.g.a.
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: August 30, 1972

Description of works of diversion, place and manner of use:
Water is developed in a 6" diameter well 70 ft. deep, from which it is pumped by a 1/2 hp submersible pump to a pressure tank and distributed to the place of use located in the same subdivision as the point of diversion, and there used for commercial and domestic purposes (duplex, office and church).

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
