CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Robert N. Caldwell, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pump and trough for stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 Sec. 2, T. 33N., R. 37E., MDB&M, or at a point from which the SE corner of said Sec. 2 bears S. 80° E. a distance of 62.0 feet situated in Pershing County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Donnell J. and Andree Richards
Post-office address: Winnemucca, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.00786 cfs or sufficient to water 250 head of cattle
Period of use, from: January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: December 11, 1972

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is pumped from a drilled well through a 1" pipeline to a 500 gallon stockwatering trough located within the same 40-acre legal subdivision as the point of diversion where it is used to water 250 head of cattle.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
