CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Harold Mead has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Lake Tahoe through a pump and pipeline for Domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 26, T. 16N., R. 18E., MDB&M, or at a point from which the N 1/4 corner of the said Sec. 26 bears N. 49° 48' 30" E., a distance of 1,291.3 feet situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Post-office address Crystal Bay, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.00223 cfs but not to exceed 0.165 mca
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation August 7, 1973

Description of works of diversion, place of use, and manner of use:
Water is pumped from Lake Tahoe by a 1 1/2 hp electrically driven pump to two 120 gallon pressure tanks in a residence located within the same subdivision as the point of diversion and there used for domestic purposes.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
