CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Mark Chilton, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an unnamed spring through diversion box, pipeline, and watering tanks for stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 32, T. 37N., R. 62E., MDB&M, or at a point from which the NE corner of said Sec. 32 bears N. 59° 32' E., a distance of 3691.78 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS. 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Post-office address Austin, Texas
Amount of appropriation 0.0218 cfs or sufficient water to water 700 head of cattle
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation March 25, 1974

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed from the spring by means of a one inch pipeline and is conveyed to 3 - 500 gallon stock watering tanks, located within the same subdivision as the point of diversion, where it is used to water 700 head of cattle.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
