CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Mark Chilton has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through well, pump, pressure tank and distribution system for Quasi-municipal purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 17, T. 34N., R. 55E., MDB&M, or at a point from which the NW corner of said Sec. 17 bears N. 6° 45' W., a distance of 1,913 ft. situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Post-office address Las Vegas, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.067 cfs, but not to exceed 0.365 mgs.
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
* Date of priority of appropriation February 16, 1972

Description of works of diversion, place of use and manner of use:
Water is developed in 6 inch dia. x 380 ft. deep well, from whence it is pumped by a submersible pump to a pressure tank and is there used for quasi-municipal purposes on a 10 acre homesite with a population of 4 persons, located in the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

*This certificate is issued to change the Point of Diversion of Permit 26553, hence the date of priority is the same as Permit 26553.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
