CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, C.H. Ketcham, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Rose Creek through reservoir, headgate, and irrigation system for irrigation purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 26, T. 35N., R. 36E., MDB&M, or at a point from which the NW corner of said Sec. 26 bears N. 59° 13' W., a distance of 5130 feet situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Post-office address Winnemucca, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 3.3 cfs, not to exceed 115.41 ac-ft per annum
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
*Date of priority of appropriation December 16, 1955

Table with 10 columns: Description of land to which the water is appurtenant, and 9 columns of acreage. Total: 375.16 acres total.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and with the understanding that the total duty of water shall not exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre per annum from any and or all sources.
*This certificate changes the place of use of permit 16821, cert. 5709, hence the date of priority of appropriation remains the same as permit 16821, cert. 5709.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
