CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Alan S. Boyack, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Meadow Spring through a cleaned spring, pond, ditch and slough for stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 5, T. 35N., R. 62E., MDB&M or at a point from which the W 1/2 corner of said Sec. 5 bears S. 75° 47' 47" W., a distance of 3434.48 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Kenneth L. and Deby A. Johns
Post-office address: Clover Valley, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.0094 cfs or sufficient to water 300 head of cattle
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: February 14, 1974

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use: The water is diverted by means of an improved spring to produce a 75' x 150' pond, with a natural outlet to a ditch and slough. The pond waters 300 head of cattle and is located within the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
