CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Mark Chilton, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, stock tank for Stockwater

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Sec. 33, T. 29N., R. 49E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the NW corner of said Sec. 33 bears N. 57° W., 78.0 feet. situated in Eureka County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Clifford Dann  
Post-office address Beowawe, Nevada  
Amount of appropriation 0.0079 c.f.s. or sufficient water for 250 head of cattle.  
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year  
Date of priority of appropriation January 13, 1975

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:  
The water is diverted from a 4" x 490" exploration well into a 10' x 20' x 2' earth stock tank through a short ditch where it is used to water 250 head of cattle in the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
