CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Richard W. Forman, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Strawberry Creek through diversion Box, pipeline and ditches for Irrigation and Domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Sec. 16, T.14N., R.69E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the W 1/4 corner of said Sec. 16 bears N. 72° 20' 00" W., a distance of 2375 feet. situated in White Pine County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Baker Ranches, Inc.
Post-office address: Baker, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 2.7 cfs but not to exceed 325. acre-feet per season.
Period of use, from: April 15 to November 1 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: July 23, 1971

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and with the understanding that the total duty of water from any and/or all sources shall not exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre per season.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
