CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, R. Leroy Givens, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for Irrigation and Domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Sec. 2, T.22S., R.61E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the SW corner of said Sec. 2 bears S. 12° 48' 45" W., a distance of 1498 feet situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.14 cfs but not to exceed 90 acre-feet per year.
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
* Date of priority of appropriation November 1, 1940

Description of the land to which the water is appurtenant:
15.0 acres in the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Sec. 2, T.22S., R.61E., M.D.B. & M.

*This certificate changes the point of diversion and place of use of permit 10579, certificate 2931; hence the date of priority of appropriation remains the same as permit 10579, certificate 2931.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
