CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Mark Chilton, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for Municipal purposes.

The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Sec. 15, T.16N., R.63E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 15 bears S. 31° 30' E., 2200.8 feet situated in White Pine County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Ely Municipal Water Department
Post-office address: Ely, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 2.0 cfs
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: May 1, 1972

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use: The water is diverted by means of a drilled well, pump and motor; then pumped into the municipal water system by means of an 8" pipeline where it is used to serve 1800 residential and 200 commercial users located within the Ely Municipality.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
