CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, B.J. Vasey, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pump and pressure tank for commercial and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Sec. 8, T.13N., R.20E., MDB&M or at a point from which the NE corner of Sec. 32, T.14N., R.20E., MDB&M bears N. 12° 04' E., a distance of 13,612 feet situated in Douglas County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year  
Date of priority of appropriation April 22, 1974

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:  
The water is diverted from a drilled well and pumped through a pressure tank and distribution system within the yard to supply waters for cooling milk and wash down water in the dairy operation located in portions of the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 and NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Sec. 8, T.13N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
