CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Frank Souza, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pump and pipeline for Municipal purposes.

The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW1/4 SE1/4 of Section 8, T.7N., R.30E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the E1/4 corner of said Section 8 bears N. 87° 14' 22" E., 1590.25 feet. situated in Mineral County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Mineral County Commissioners
Post-office address: Hawthorne, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.10 c.f.s. but not to exceed 23.59 million gallons annually
Period of use, from: January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: April 11, 1972

Description of the works of diversion manner and place of use: The water is diverted by means of a drilled well and pumped into the Corey Canyon Transmission Line to the Township of Hawthorne, Nevada, where it is used for municipal purposes within the S1/2 S1/2 Section 22, Section 27, E1/2 Section 28, N1/2 NW1/4, NW1/4 NE1/4 Section 34, all in T.8N., R.30E., M.D.B. & M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
