CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Frank Souza, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well pump and transmission lines for Municipal purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE1/4 NE1/4 of Section 33, T.8N., R.30E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the E1/4 corner of said Section 33 bears S. 79° 21' 52" E., a distance of 684.63 feet. situated in Mineral County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Description of the works of diversion manner and place of use:
The water is diverted from the drilled well, and pumped into the transmission line for municipal use within the Town of Hawthorne, Nevada, described as being the S1/2 S1/2 Section 22, Section 27, N1/2 NW1/4, NW1/4 NE1/4 Section 34, and E1/2 Section 28, all in T.8N., R.30E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
