CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, G. G. Gressman, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source

through a drilled well, pump and storage tank for mining and milling

purposes. The point of diversion of water from this source is as follows: NE1/4 SW1/4 of Section 5, T.6N., R.35E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the S1/4 corner of said Section 5, bears S. 30° 06' E., a distance of 1582.25 feet.

situated in Mineral County, State of Nevada:

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator James H. Madden

Post-office address Mina, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.67 c.f.s., but not to exceed 131.40 million gallons annually.

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year

Date of priority of appropriation July 7, 1969

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

The water is diverted from a 300 foot deep, 8 inch cased well and pumped to a 15,000 gallon storage tank where it is used to serve a mining and milling operation equipped with four tables and six small flotation cells, all located in the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
