CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Burton Lee Kennington, Permittee has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pump, and distribution system for

Quasi-Municipal purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 Sec. 8, T.20N., R.19E., MDB&M or at a point from which the SE corner of said Sec. 8 bears S. 17° 14" E., a distance of 1150.0 feet

situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.135 cfs but not to exceed 3.643 m.g.a.
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation July 3, 1970

Description of the works of diversion, manner, and place of use:
The water is diverted by means of a drilled 165 foot well, and pumped through a trident water meter to serve five homes, one hardware store, and landscaping to include 150 trees, 75 bushes and lawn area, all located in the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
