CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Opal Radcliffe, Permittee has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pump and pipeline for commercial purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW1/4 NE1/4 of Section 29, T.6N., R.35E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the N1/4 corner of said Section 29, bears N. 09° 06' 30" W., a distance of 1683.65 feet. situated in Mineral County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.025 c.f.s. but not to exceed 0.493 m.g.a.
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation August 23, 1974

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:
The water is diverted from a drilled well and piped to a house (bar) and trailer houses where it is used for commercial purposes in the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
