CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, J. R. Caldwell, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pump and pipelines for Industrial and Domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE1/4 NW1/4 of Section 25, T.36N., R.37E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the W1/4 corner of said Section 25 bears S. 89° 49' W., a distance of 1900 feet. situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.96 c.f.s. but not to exceed 39.39 million gallons annually.
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation July 15, 1976

Description of The works of diversion, manner and place of use:
The water is diverted from a drilled well and piped immediately within the plant for potato processing, packing and storage, and domestic uses located within portions of the S1/2 NW1/4 and N1/2, SW1/4 and SW1/4, NE1/4 of Section 25, T.36N., R.37E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
