CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Alan S. Boyack, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pump and pressure system for domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 Sec. 1, T38N, R69E, MDB&M, or at a point from which the NW corner of said sec. 1 bears N 46° 02' 42" W, a distance of 899.5 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.05 cfs, not to exceed 0.11 mga
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation May 16, 1973

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:
The water is diverted by means of a drilled well and pumped to a trailer house where it is used to water a lawn, garden, and shrubs besides the domestic use at the trailer, all located in the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
