CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Mark Chilton, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Johnson Creeks through a small dam and ditch for stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 sec. 3, T34N, R62E, MDB&M or at a point from which the E 1/4 corner of said sec. 3 bears N 1° 30' E, 20 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Vernon & Jean Westwood
Post-office address: Wells, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.0125 cfs or sufficient to water 300 cattle and 100 horses
Period of use, from: January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: June 10, 1974

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use: The water is diverted from Johnson Creeks via a small dam directly into an un-named ditch of approximately 1.5 miles in length where the cattle and horses water along its length. The dam is 5 feet high by 15 feet in length, and constructed of earth/

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
