CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Mark Chilton, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from unnamed stream #1S through a diversion dam and ditch for stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 Sec. 27, T35N, R62E, MDB&M or at a point from which the N 1/4 corner of said sec. 27 bears N 89° 09' W. 359.0 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Vernon & Joan Westwood
Post-office address: Wells, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.0125 cfs or sufficient to water 300 head of cattle and 100 horses
Period of use, from: January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: June 10, 1974

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:
The water is claimed from the stream by means of a low dam (4 feet high, 8 feet wide, and 500 feet long) into a 1/2 mile long ditch from which the stock are allowed to water located in the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
